ANTITYPE

ANTITYPE (Grk. antitupon, a "counterpart"; Heb 9:24). That which is represented or prefigured by a *type*. The *type* may be considered a rough draft, while the antitype is the perfect image. The type is a figure, and antitype is the reality that the type prefigured, as Christ is the antitype of the Paschal Lamb. (From The New Unger's Bible Dictionary)
