

ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

- 3 graduated apprentices
- 42,641 drinks sold
- 3,960 hours in operation
- 16 employees at one time (most ever!)



RECOVERY & REUNIFICATION

- 13 women impacted by the Hannah House
- 19 kids represented
- 4 Genesis Process completions
- 4 successful transitions (3 were into KMC properties)
- 31 volunteers served



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

- 255 tenants served through KMC
- 74 affordable, quality apartments managed
