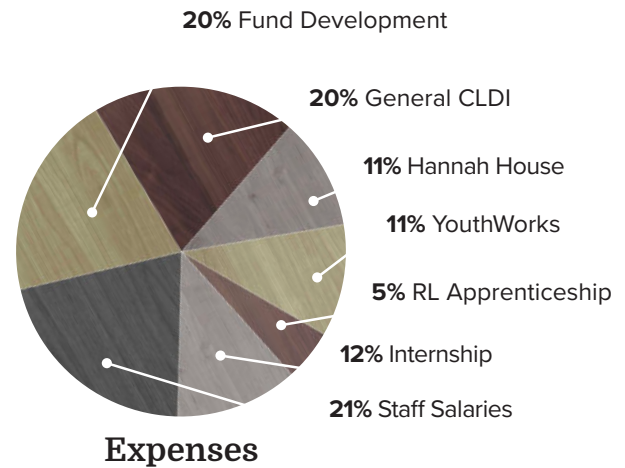
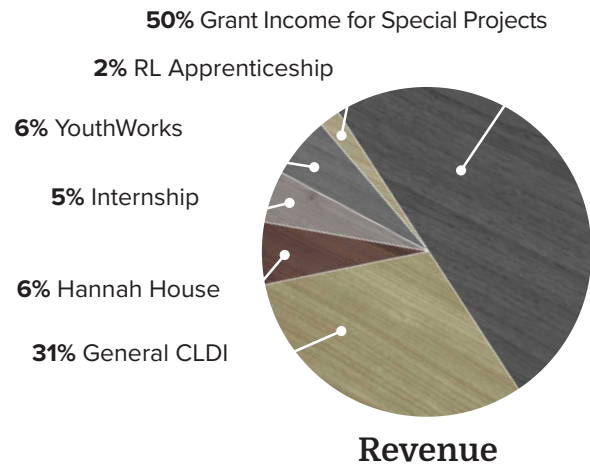

ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

- 3 graduated apprentices
- 35,432 drinks sold
- 3,000 hours in operation
- Busiest day on record
- 14 employees at one time (most ever!)



RECOVERY & REUNIFICATION

- 18 women impacted by the Hannah House
- 29 kids represented
- 5 Genesis Process completions
- 5 successful transitions (3 were into KMC properties)
- 238 volunteer hours served
