

## **How this approach sets us up for release and success in our Savior's eyes.**

**If we are delivering God's truth we are emotionally off the hook! And cannot take another's reaction personally**

**STEP #1: After salvation is addressed and agreed upon we can then begin referring to them as a "Christ Follower" I John 2:3-6**

**STEP #2: We can reduce the amount of conversation to Biblical planning and encourage obedience as the only option! Simplify Rom. 2:15**

**STEP #3: Then ask "what is the amount of authority you are willing to give me?" This speaks volumes to my approach and commitment to my new friend. Therefore I refuse to be more committed to their walk than they are.**

**STEP #4: Pay attention to the level of understanding of the Scriptures on their part and educate accordingly. Never assume one knows more than the basic fundamentals. Educate them on the 1050 commands and what is actually "Biblical Sin" (offense example) Acts 3:19**

**STEP #5 & 6: Our desire; to have one look within. Never assume the process is over! Press in! (see lists, listen, pay attention to tone and body language) Have them explain to you the process of repentance.) 2 Cor. 7:9-10**

**STEP #7: You are giving them all the tools they need for success in personal relationships. 2 Cor. 3:17**

**STEP #8: MEMORIZE! MEMORIZE! MEMORIZE! RECEIVE!  
MEMORIZE!**

**Have the person convince you that they know how to receive a verse. Sharing how that truth transformed them. Example 2 Tim 1:7 fear**

**STEP #9: (Rare, but glorious) Praise the Lord if the person receives and gets what you have grasped! Celebrate! Pass the victory on the Jesus Titus 2:15!**
