**5 But if anyone obeys his word, God's love is truly made complete in him. This is how we know we are in him: NIV**

**1 John 2:15**

**15 Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. NIV**

**1 John 3:17-18**

**17 If anyone has material possessions and sees his brother in need but has no pity on him, how can the love of God be in him? 18 Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth. NIV**

**1 John 4:12**

**12 No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us.

**1 John 4:16-21**

**16 And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him. 17 In this way, love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment, because in this world we are like him. 18 There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love. 19 We love because he first loved us. 20 If anyone says, "I love God," yet hates his brother, he is a liar. For anyone who does not love his brother, whom he has seen, cannot love God, whom he has not seen. 21 And he has given us this command: Whoever loves God must also love his brother.

**1 John 5:1-3**

**1 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God, and everyone who loves the father loves his child as well. 2 This is how we know that we love the children of God: by loving God and carrying out his commands. 3 This is love for God: to obey his commands. And his commands are not burdensome, NIV**

**2 John 6**

**6 And this is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands. As you have heard from the beginning, his command is that you walk in love.
