1. Bible comes from the word for papyrus plant
2. Chapter Divisions came in 1200's
3. 1550 (verses were finalized) Robert Stevens 1663 – 1st Bible Translated in America
4. Gutenberg printing press - 1455 (John Gutenberg moveable type)
5. Torah
6. Pentateuch – 1st 5 Books of the Bible
7. Ezra 400 BC assembled the Old Testament (Parchment – Sheep Skin)
8. AD 210 Origen (James and Jude were excluded)
AD 314 Eusebius (Revelation excluded)
AD 315 Athanasius recommended 27 NT Books
9. Jerome AD 382 – Latin Vulgate (Vulgate – common language (used Greek to obtain Latin Translation
10. Senate of Carthage AD 397 – officially declared our present 27 Books as Scripture and the Septuagint as the OT. (Apocrypha was to be used for instruction)
11. By AD 400 Scriptures were translated into 500 languages. The Roman church restricted used to Latin. AD 400 – AD 1400 The Dark & Middle Ages
12. The Catholic Church required: confession, penance, pilgrimages, adoration of saints, the doctrine of transubstantiation, indulgences (the Pope became all powerful)
13. Indulgences – Tariffs established by Pope John XXII
 - a. Ravishing a virgin \$2.00
 - b. Murder of a layman \$1.75
 - c. All crimes \$12.00
 - d. Robbing a church \$2.25
 - e. Burning a house \$2.70
 - f. Forgery & lying \$2.00
 - g. Eating meat in Lent \$2.75
 - h. Striking a priest \$2.75
 - i. Robbery \$3.00
14. Augustine – proclamation that prostitution was a necessary evil
15. Pope Leo X (holy wars to kill Jews) (how profitable to us has been the fable of Christ) – finance the building of the Vatican
16. Urban VI vs. Clement VII (each claimed to be Pope)
17. Iona in Scotland (The Culdees) – Secret Society 563 AD – Columba started a Bible college helped preserve the bible
18. Joseph of Aramathea built first church in Glasonburg England
19. John Wycliffe – 1300's Pastor/Teacher @Oxford translated Bible into English. He was a product of the Secret Bible Society (Culdees)
20. Cannibal feast of Baal (The Catholic Priests held the mass in a Cannibalistic manner.) Hocus Pocus
21. 1384 Wycliffe suffered a stroke and died
22. 1408 Archbishop of York forbid any translation into English
23. John Huss 1416 follower of Wycliffe
24. 1517 Martin Luther's 98 Theses
25. John Collett & Savana Rolla – began (1490's) to teach the letters of Paul in common language
26. Erasmus of Rotterdam -- read & translated every piece of literature that was available
27. 1514-1515 Erasmus began to compile a Greek Bible for the printing press (complete 1516)
28. English Reformation – Thomas Billne (1st Martyr of English Reformation)@Cambridge University

29. William Tyndale – father of English language (died in poverty and exile) 1494- 1536 Spoke 8 languages fluently – Tyndale English New Testament White House Inn Society
30. Tyndale visited with Martin Luther (Bounty hunters were employed)
31. Tyndale imprisoned for 500 days then strangled and burned
32. 1537 Henry VIII gave license to print the 1st English Bible printed in England. (The Great Bible)
33. The Martyrs – (Fox’s Book of Martyrs – most popular book in 1600’s)
34. John Rogers – burned; Coverdale escaped
35. During Queen Mary’s reign – over 300 Protestant scholars were burned
36. Geneva Bible (1st bible with verses) 1560 (Coverdale and Knox) a bible school in a single volume (Shakespeare quotes from this translation over 5000 times) 1st Bible with verses on Mayflower.
37. Martin Luther
38. Scripture was perverted by the Latin as a method of controlling the people
39. 1517 Martin Luther – proclaimed the doctrine of faith Hab. 2:4; Heb. 11:6; Rom. 1:17
40. 1521 – Worms, Germany (Martin Luther proclaims his belief in the Scripture (German Translation done by Martin Luther
41. King James Bible – 50 scholars; 6 groups – 1611 Completed (90% of Tyndale’s Bible was included)
42. Apocryphal Books
43. The bible influence in America – The Continental Congress – The Bible Congress
44. Declaration of Independence, U.S. Constitution, and Bill of Rights were all influences by the Bible
